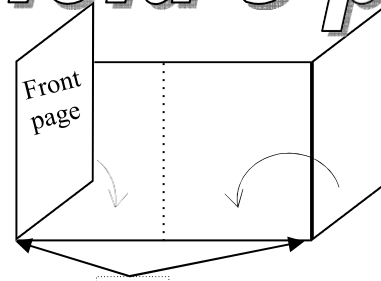
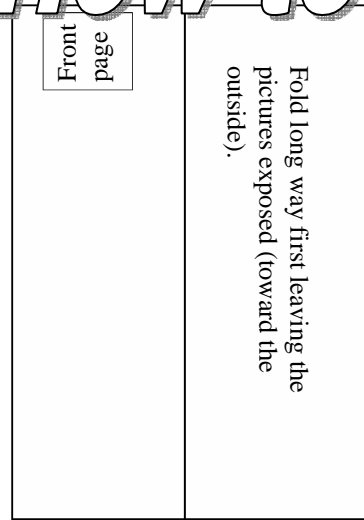
Directions:

4. Use the booklets and pictures to tell the story.

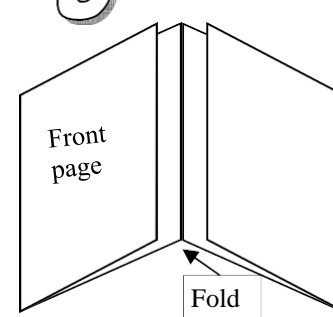

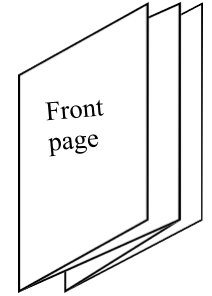
How to fold 8 page booklet



Fold first and last page to meet in the center.

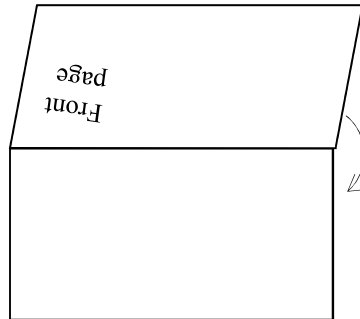


Fold the center and bend backwards.

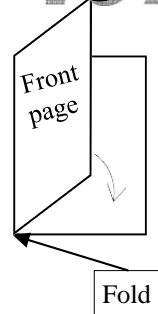


The final booklet is an accordion-style book.

How to fold



Fold the page the short length first, leaving the pictures visible (outside).



Now fold the opposite direction, leaving the front page as the cover of the book.

4 page booklet



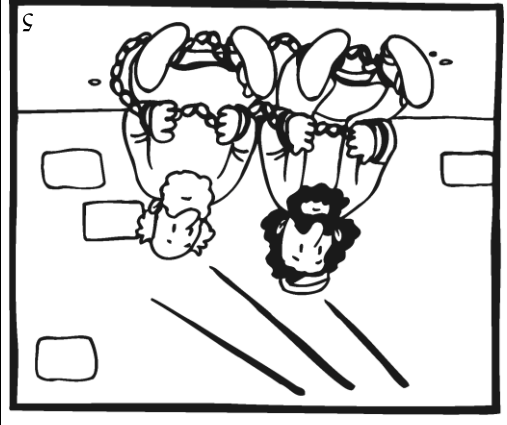
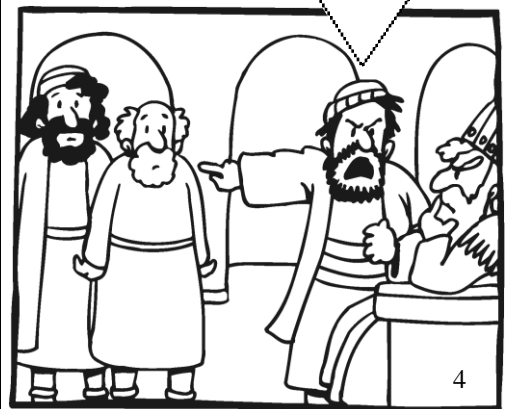
A vision appeared to Paul in the night: a man of Macedonia was standing there, urging him and saying, "Come over to Macedonia and help us."
